

DEC ordered by Hon'ble Delhi High Court to indicate correct recognition status of SCDL

It is to inform you that in a petition filed by Symbiosis Centre of Distance Learning (SCDL) against the Distance Education Council (DEC), AICTE, UGC and MHRD, the Hon'ble Delhi High Court has ruled in the favour of SCDL. After hearing the merits of the case, the Hon'ble Delhi High Court has ordered that the provisional recognition given to SCDL continues till the Tripartite Committee takes a decision. Taking into consideration the long and undue delay on part of the DEC, the Hon'ble High Court has given 3 months period to the Tripartite Committee to communicate its decision. DEC has also been directed to rectify its official website to indicate that DEC recognition to SCDL and its programs continues till date (2011-12) and same should be reflected in the list of Universities/Institutes accorded course-wise regular recognition (as on 16th Aug 2011) and the list of Universities/Institutes approved by Distance Education Council, within three days from the date of the order (i.e. 12 Oct 2011).

As per the order of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court, SCDL's provisional recognition granted earlier is still continuing and shall continue till a final decision is taken by DEC. The same has been displayed by the DEC on its official website.
